The Parties hereby consent to this Agreed Permanent Injunction ("Injunction").

Defendant is hereby permanently enjoined from:

- I. Soliciting consumers either directly or indirectly for mobile home transport and repair services; and
- II. Engaging in consumer transactions involving mobile home transport and repair services;

Defendant is required to cancel his registered trade name "David's Mobile Home and Well Service" with the Secretary of State within 30 days of signing this agreement. Defendant must file a new registered trade name for any other business he owns.

This Injunction represents the full and complete agreement between the Parties. The Injunction is to remain in effect permanently unless modified or vacated by further Order of this Court.


