Pursuant to Civil Rule 53, the Court hereby adopts the Magistrate's Decision entered on January 27, 2023. The objection period has expired with no objections having been filed and no extensions having been granted.

The decision in which the Magistrate granted default judgment in favor of the Plaintiff, the State of Ohio, and against the Defendants, Defendants Tara Curles and her business Window Planet, Inc., and found the following

- Plaintiff's request for Declaratory Judgment is GRANTED, and it is therefore DECLARED that the acts and practices set forth above violate the CSPA, R.C. 1345.01 et seq. and its Substantive Rules, in the manner set forth herein.
- 2. Defendants, individually or doing business under any other names, their agents, employees, successors or assigns, and all persons acting in concert and participation with them, directly or indirectly, through any corporate device, partnership, or other association, under these or any other names, are hereby PERMANENTLY ENJOINED from engaging in the acts and practices of which Plaintiff complains and from further violating the CSPA, R.C. 1345.01 et seq., and its Substantive Rules.

THE CLERK SHALL SERVE NOTICE TO PARTIES PURSUANT TO CIVIL RULE 58 WHICH SHALL BE TAXED AS COSTS HEREIN. 3. Defendants, individually and doing business under any other names, are hereby PERMANENTLY ENJOINED from engaging in business as a Supplier in any consumer transactions in this state until such time as they have satisfied all monetary obligations ordered by this Court and any other Court in Ohio in connection with a consumer transaction.

4. Defendants are ORDERED to pay actual consumer damages to the Ohio Attorney General in the total amount of \$169,985.50 to be distributed by the Ohio Attorney General to the 70 consumers identified in Exhibit 1 to the Damages Memo.

5. Based on the above findings that Defendants committed unfair and deceptive acts and practices in violation of the CSPA, and pursuant to R.C. 1345.07(D), Defendants are ORDERED to pay a civil penalty to the Ohio Attorney General in the amount of \$75,000.00.
