- B. Defendants, individually or doing business under any other names, their agents, employees, successors or assigns, and all persons acting in concert and participation with them, directly or indirectly, through any corporate device, partnership, or other association, under these or any other names, are hereby PERMANENTLY ENJOINED from engaging in the acts and practices of which Plaintiff complains and from further violating the CSPA, R.C. 1345.01 et seq., its Substantive Rules, and the HSSA, R.C. 1345.21 et seqRECEIVED ATTORNEY GENERAL OF OHIO

- F. Based on the above findings that Defendant Edward Boswell committed unfair and deceptive acts and practices in violation of the CSPA, and pursuant to R.C. 1345.07(D), Defendant Edward Boswell is ORDERED to pay a civil penalty to the Ohio Attorney General in the amount of \$10,000.00,

Defendants, individually and doing business under any other names, are hereby PERMANENTLY ENJOINED from engaging in business as a Supplier in any consumer transactions in this state until such time as Defendants have satisfied all monetary obligations ordered pursuant to this litigation, the judgment against Defendants in State of
