The Plaintiff, State of Ohio, commenced this action on April 28, 2016 by filing its Complaint and Request for Declaratory Judgment, Injunctive Relief, Consumer Restitution, and Civil Penalties against Defendants Prime Technologies, LLC and Linda Brown Massey (collectively "Defendants"). The Complaint alleged violations of the Consumer Sales Practices Act R.C. 1345.01 et seq. ("CSPA") and the Telephone Solicitation Sales Act, R.C. 4719.01 et seq. ("TSSA"). The Defendants were served on May 4, 2016 and failed to respond within the twenty-eight days allotted under the rules. Defendants have failed to make any appearance in this action.

Plaintiff filed a Motion for Default Judgment on June 7, 2016. On July 8, 2016, the Court issued an Order Granting Plaintiff's Motion for Default Judgment. The Court granted Plaintiff's Motion as to liability and granted Plaintiff's request to present evidence of consumer damages via affidavits at a damages hearing.

On September 16, 2016, Plaintiff filed a Motion to Award Consumer Damages and Civil Penalties ("Damages Motion"). In support of its request for consumer damages, Plaintiff

attached to its Damages Motion the affidavits of 22 consumers, which attested to the damages suffered by those consumers. The affidavits established that each of the consumers sustained monetary damages, totaling \$67,628.82, in connection with Defendants' computer repair business. The Court finds that each consumer sustained individual damages in the amounts set forth in the Consumer Damages List (attached as Exhibit 1 to Plaintiff's Damages Motion).

In its Damages Motion, Plaintiff also explained the basis for the amount of civil penalties requested. Plaintiff's request was made pursuant to R.C. 1345.07(D). Plaintiff provided evidence of the Defendants' violations of the CSPA which, pursuant to R.C. 1345.07(D), permit the imposition of a civil penalty in the amount of \$50,000.00.

Upon review of Plaintiff's Damages Motion and the attached exhibits, the Court finds that Plaintiff's Damages Motion is well-taken. The Court **GRANTS** said Motion and orders as follows:

- A. Plaintiff's request for Declaratory Judgment is **GRANTED**, and it is therefore **DECLARED** that the acts and practices set forth in the Complaint violate the CSPA and the TSSA in the manner described therein.
- B. Defendants, their agents, servants, employees, successors or assigns, and all persons acting in concert and participation with them, directly or indirectly, through any corporate device, partnership, or other association, under these or any other names, are **PERMANENTLY ENJOINED** from engaging in the acts and practices of which Plaintiff complains and from further violating the CSPA, R.C. 1345.01 et seq. or the TSSA, R.C. 4719.01 et seq.
- C. Pursuant to R.C. 1345.07(B), Defendants are **ORDERED** to pay damages to the Ohio consumers identified in the affidavits provided to the Court who were injured by the

Defendants' conduct set forth herein in the amount of \$67,628.82. Such payment shall be made to the Attorney General via certified check or money order payable to the "Ohio Attorney General" and delivered to:

The consumer damages will be distributed by the Attorney General to the following consumers in the amounts set forth below:

D. Based on the findings that Defendants committed unfair, deceptive, and unconscionable acts and practices in violation of the CSPA, Defendants are **ORDERED** to pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$50,000.00, pursuant to R.C. 1345.07(D). Such payment shall be made to the Attorney General via certified check or money order payable to the "Ohio Attorney General" and delivered to:

Compliance Officer Consumer Protection Section Office of the Ohio Attorney General 30 East Broad Street, 14th Floor Columbus, Ohio 43215

- E. Defendants are **ENJOINED** from engaging in business as a supplier in any consumer transactions in the State of Ohio, until such time as they have satisfied all monetary obligations assessed at the damages hearing.
- F. Defendants are **ORDERED** to pay all court costs.

entry upon all parties.
